

Dear VHS Parents and Senior Students,

May 26th, 9:00 am, on Bob Rumrill Field, at Viking Stadium is Graduation Day. It will be sunny and a great day for a graduation. Seniors you have put in so much hard work over the last thirteen years of school, you only have a short time before your journey is finished at VHS. I hope you have had an enjoyable Winter Break and a successful Fall Semester. I hope you are ready for a fast paced Spring.

Below is a list of dates that will be coming up in the Spring:

Feb 15th, the Weld County District Attorney office will be here to present to all students the new sexting law that came into effect in January. Sexting is increasingly becoming an issue throughout the country and we want students to be aware of the consequences. Parents will also have an opportunity to hear about this law in the Fall of 2018.

Senior Announcements will be delivered the first week of March. We will send a phone call home when the official date becomes clear.

April 10th is the **Senior Trip** at Dave and Busters. You must have completed your ICAP, paid your fees, completed book reports, no discipline problems in the Spring Semester and be passing all classes that are required for graduation. More details on the cost to student, time, etc.. for the Senior Trip will come through Mrs. Rewerts.

April 30th, at 6:00pm, in the auditorium will be the **Senior Parent Night**. I ask that at least one family member and/or the student attends. This meeting takes thirty minutes at the most. We will go over the appropriate dress for students, expectations at graduation, a list of items your student has/has not completed in order to graduate, last minute details for graduation week, give out field passes for graduation, and answer any last minute questions about graduation.

May 4th, by 4:00 pm, **ICAP Requirements** are completed and signed off by Mrs. Cress. Completing your ICAP is a requirement in order to graduate, walk in graduation, and receive your diploma. If your student does not complete ICAP by this time, **they will not walk at graduation.** If you would like to know the status of the completion of ICAP at this point, please contact Mrs. Cress (cresss@wcsdre1.org).

May 11th, by 4:00 pm, all **Book Reports** are completed and turned in to Mr. Dowd. Completing your book reports is a requirement in order to graduate, walk in graduation, and receive your diploma. If your student does not complete their Book Reports by this time, **they will not walk at graduation.** If you would like to know the status of the completion of book reports at this point, please contact Mr. Dowd (dowda@wcsdre1.org).

May 22nd, May 23rd will be Senior Finals.

May 24th, at 7:00 pm, will be **Senior Awards Night** in the West Gym. We will be having a Senior Picture at 6:15 pm before the ceremony.
