

DISTRICT PERSONNEL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION COUNCIL

An advisory school district personnel performance evaluation council shall be appointed by the Board of Education. The council will consist of, at a minimum, one teacher, one administrator, one principal from the school district, one resident from the school district who is a parent of a child attending school within the district, and one resident of the school district who is not a parent with a child in the district.

The council shall consult with the Board as to the fairness, effectiveness, credibility and professional quality of the licensed personnel performance evaluation system and its processes and procedures. The evaluation of the system shall be continuous.
